

Garter Stitch Mohair and 8 ply Beanie

Yarn: 1 ball 12 ply Mohair
1 ball 8 ply wool

Needles: 1 pair 7.50 mm

Using one strand of each yarn, cast on 62 stitches and work in Garter Stitch (knit plain) until work measures 17 cm from beg.

Next Row: (K2 tog K13) 3 times, K2 tog, K15 (58 sts)

Work one row in garter stitch

Next Row: *K2 tog K4, rep from * to last 10 sts (k2 tog K3) twice (48 sts).

Next Row: Knit

Next Row: *K2 tog K3 rep from * to last 8 sts(K2 tog K2) twice (38 sts)

Next Row: Knit

Next Row: *K2 tog, K2, rep from * to last 6 sts (K2 tog K1) twice (28 sts)

Continue in garter stitch until work measures 23 cm from beginning

Next Row: K2 tog across row (14 sts)

Next Row: Knit remaining 14 sts

Next Row: K2 tog across row (7 sts).

Break off yarn and draw through remaining 7 stitches. Fasten off. Sew up back seam.

Note: As meterage quoted on ball band is approximate, should you run out of the 8 ply just before the end, you will be able to complete your beanie quite successfully by simply knitting your mohair double until it is finished.
